



#### STEP 1

Shelf is screwed in place for shipping, use phillips head screwdriver to remove screws from shelf pins. Four screws per shelf. Refer to the drawing below:





Anti-tip hardware kit must always be used to prevent the case from tipping. Attach anti-tip restraint at top of the case inline to meet attachment on wall. Screw anti-tip into wall stud or use appropriate anchor for the type of wall if not drywall. Adjust leveler if needed.




